

Year 2 of WCC was developed to reflect both NHS feedback . . .



... and changes in the economic context

Potential £20bn gap between 2011-14

Challenge is to increase productivity and quality at the same time

This is the essence of commissioning

This has resulted in a number of improvements . . .

WCC assurance has been refined, and **slimmed down** to help PCTs **focus on the core activities that underpin WCC assurance** rather than on WCC assurance itself

- 1 Clearer description of competencies, and sub-competencies in particular
- 2 Published criteria for the assessment of PCTs in all aspects of governance
- 3 Greater distinction between each rating in all aspects of governance
- 4 Improved metrics for outcomes
- 5 Comprehensive, online datapacks
- A clear, transparent and aligned approach between the three regulatory systems of the Audit Commission, Care Quality Commission and the Department of Health
- 7 Better trained, more prepared panellists
- 8 More user-friendly and informative web-based assurance toolkit
- 9 Requirement for PCTs to signpost evidence for analysts and analysts to provide more focussed panel information, reducing burden across the system

... other changes

- 1 Competency 11, ensuring efficiency and effectiveness of spend, is now being assessed as part of the core competencies
- 2 Competency 6 requires PCTs to prioritise investment in different financial scenarios
- 3 PCTs are asked to describe how they will demonstrate improvements to date and set year-on-year aspirations for the next five years
- 4 PCTs will self-assess against all three aspects of governance
- 5 Strengthened strategy section
- 6 Revised financial template demonstrating the link between strategy and finance, not a full financial assessment
- 7 Greater focus on board ownership and responsibility for managing risk, strategic development and delivery
- 8 Involvement of PCT chief executives and chairs in wider panel discussions

We have ensured that WCC fits in with other commissioning arrangements

Collaborative commissionin g

 A tailored WCC assurance process has been designed and will evolve as these commissioning arrangements continue to develop

Specialised commissionin g

- As these arrangements are implemented at the local level, they are not subject to WCC assurance
- A 'development tool', grounded in WCC, has been designed for local implementation
