




## Matched funding scheme


It's aim was to help:


- the majority of publicly-funded English higher education institutions to achieve a step change in fund-raising.
- our most successful fund-raisers to compete globally by offering an additional grant for those who raise the highest amounts in donations. These grants will be on a 3:1 private to public ratio.
- other publicly-funded HE providers in England to increase their fund-raising capacity.



























# Capacity building

### CASE programme 2008-12



- 87% of institutions have participated so far expected to rise to 90% by this summer
- Over 1,000 delegates
- Across all three tiers

### Graduate Trainee programme

- Year long programme in host HEI with strong development departments
- Builds capacity for the future
- 21 trainees so far over three years, with almost all staying in HE
- Fourth year added



# Leadership in Development Management

- Programme also being extended until March 2013
- Targeted at new development directors

- Review of Philanthropic Support for Higher Education in the UK
  - Report in July
  - Will look at how best HEFCE can support recommendations
- Continuing support for ROSS-CASE survey
