Palace Road Hostel




 Palace Road 2007-2012 - 10 unplanned pregnancies, 6 children entered care

Case Study




- History in Care

Issue: Contraceptive needs not met



- Mainstream team currently only able to provide condoms, emergency contraception, advice
- Chaotic lifestyles
- Lack of trust
- Services not client centred


First thought – Depo Provera PGD








Second thought – Implants








Client centered approach

- Servicebased in hostel
- Staff training
- Needs assessment
- Choice of contraception



Beer Goggles...!!!



Outcomes so far...

- Meaningful engagement with 13 women
- 4 clients had a full sexual health screen
- 2 clients wanted the patch, and 6 implants inserted
- 1 client then attended local sexual health clinic of own accord
