
AELP/LSIS snapshot survey



Sept/Oct 2011 – Key Stats

- 22% were delivering mainly Key Skills (KS) with some Functional Skills (FS)
- 8% were delivering mainly FS with some KS
- 8% were delivering 100% FS
- In short 92% of providers were, to one extent or another, delivering KS as part of their provision, with only 8% having made the full transition (or have always delivered FS)
- 62% of providers were delivering 100% Key Skills (KS)

AELP/LSIS snapshot survey – six months on



- Number delivering 100% KS has dropped by 21%
- ...these 21% have, to one extent or another, started to deliver
- However, providers who have made the full transition has only increased by 1%
- 41% are still delivering just KS
