Relationship Abuse Amongst Young People

- **16-24 year olds are more likely to experience domestic violence in their relationships than people in older age groups.** (British Crime Survey, 2006)
- **Only 33% of young people who are in abusive relationships tell someone about it.** (Women's Aid 2011)
- **72% of young people at school have been bullied while they are online.** (Juvonen and Gross 2008)
